

Subject: First Aid Tool Box Talk No.: 005

The priorities of first aid are to: save life, prevent the casualty's condition from getting worse and to evacuate to medical help as soon as possible.

If you know basic first aid, you could save a life.

Ensure you know where the first-aid kit is kept and how to contact a first aid person If in any doubt always call the emergency services on 999.

When first aid is required:

- Call for medical help, e.g. first-aider.
- Ensure your own safety as you approach the casualty.
- Remove the hazard from the casualty if safe to do so.
- Send someone to phone for an ambulance if necessary.
- Don't move the casualty, unless in immediate danger.
- On finding a casualty:
- Remain with them and give reassurance
- Make them as comfortable as possible but don't give drinks or food to casualty, moisten lips only.
- Don't allow them to smoke.
